

Starting Monday, August 15, a construction project initiated by the Ohio Department of Transportation will have a major impact on the flow of traffic out of Main Campus.

For about a month, drivers on Valentine Avenue will only be able to travel westbound toward Scranton Road. Drivers will not be able to access 176-S and 71-S from Valentine.

EMS/FIRE who need to access 176-S and 71-S will need to take alternate routes (see the map below). Options include:

- Take Scranton Road north, turn right on Clark Avenue then turn right on West 14th to access 71-S via the roundabout.
- 71-S can be accessed via West 25th Street.
- 176-S can be accessed via Denison Avenue.

We strongly advise familiarizing yourself with this new route in advance of the detour.

The entire project is expected to be completed by the end of October. We will keep you posted as the project progresses. Thank you for your patience and flexibility.



W. 14th St. ramp reconfiguration



Access to I-71 and SR 176 southbound from Valentine Ave. in the city of Cleveland will be closed for approximately 30 days for work on the W. 14th St. ramp reconfiguration. The tentative start date for this closure is Tuesday, August 15, 2023.

The detour for I-71 southbound will be Valentine Ave. to Scranton Rd. to Metrohealth Dr. to W. 25th St. The detour for SR 176 will continue on W. 25th St. to Denison Ave.

Access is estimated to re-open in mid-September.



To I-77 Southbound

- Turn left out of hospital onto Valentine Ave.
- Turn left onto Scranton Rd.
- Turn right onto Metrohealth Dr.
- Turn left onto W. 25th St.
- Turn right onto I-71 southbound

To SR 176 Southbound

- Turn left out of hospital onto Valentine Ave.
- Turn left onto Scranton Rd.
- Turn right onto Metrohealth Dr.
- Turn left onto W. 25th St.
- Turn left onto Denison Ave.
- Turn right onto SR 176 southbound

To SR 176 Southbound from Ambulance Bay:

- Turn right from amb bay onto View Rd and proceed to W. 25th
- Turn left onto W. 25 and proceed to Denison
- Turn left onto Denison
- Turn right onto SR 176 South
